



Speech Pathologists/Teachers of the Deaf (Full and part-time positions) Western and Northern Melbourne

Taralye, a not-for-profit organisation, is a leader in the provision of services for children who are deaf throughout Victoria. Established in 1968, Taralye's vision is that "Children who are deaf will listen, learn and speak to their full potential". Services include an audiology/otology clinic, an early intervention program, inclusive early childhood programs and support for school-aged children.

Taralye is undergoing rapid growth in demand for service. We are now recruiting speech pathologists and/or teachers of the deaf for full time and/or part-time positions including maternity replacement positions. Employment is for an initial 12 month period with the possibility of extension. Positions will be based in either the western or northern metropolitan suburbs.

Reporting to the Manager Early Intervention, the roles have responsibility for:

- the assessment of children who are deaf in collaboration with families and early intervention key workers (including undertaking speech and language assessments)
- management of a caseload of children who are deaf utilising a family-centred, evidence-based approach
- provision of intervention in small group settings

Prior experience in working with children who are deaf (birth – 12 years) and a strong interest in data quality and continuous improvement related to hearing impairment and speech and language development would be advantageous. A car and current Victorian driver's license are required.

Conditions of employment will be commensurate with qualifications and experience including generous salary packaging opportunities.
