Greatorex stuns at national titles

NUNAWADING'S Sam Greatorex produced a stunning performance at the Australian Age Multi-Class Championships in Adelaide recently.

Sam, who has a hearing disability, was on fire at the three-day meet securing one gold, three silver and two bronze medals.

In his main event, the 100m breaststroke, Sam swam a three-second personal best time and broke an Australian age record, which had not been bettered for 11 years, to win in a time of 1min 22.28sec.

Sam also took the silver in the 100m backstroke, breaking another long-standing record (since 2001) in a time of 1min 10.58sec, and then backed up just 30 minutes later to win silver in the 50m breaststroke in another personal best time of 37.81sec.

Sam also won a silver in the 100m free-style, in a personal best 1min 03.20sec.

He also won bronze medals in the boys 11-15 years 200m individual medley, breaking his own Australian age record for his disability with 2min 34.98sec, and the boys 11-14 years 50m backstroke, breaking another Australian age record with a 33.53sec.
